WAVELL AVENUE was caught in tight between rivals near the five-eighths marker and steadied slightly, quickly leveled back into stride and took closer order through traffic, shifted out leaving the turn, quickened once uncovered when straightening for the drive, reeled in LA VERDAD and edged away. LA VERDAD was away in good order, controlled the tempo off of the inside, came in a bit entering the stretch and tightened up TARIS near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted back out a path while fighting on resiliently, but was unable to resist the winner. TARIS attended the pace along the inside, was blocked entering the stretch when LA VERDAD came in and waited briefly, found a seam when that one moved back out, continued on willingly but was unable to improve position. CAVORTING was unhurried into stride, worked her way forward through the turn, came seven wide and was making up ground under stern left handed urging. JUDY THE BEAUTY contended between horses four deep, was within striking distance entering the stretch, bumped with MERRY

MEADOW repeatedly through the drive and failed to make headway. MERRY MEADOW was close up six wide, was collared between horses on the turn, bumped with JUDY THE BEAUTY through the lane and finished evenly. ROOM FOR ME came away a step slow, tucked in to save ground, angled out leaving the turn, and was making up ground between foes. STONETASTIC tracked the pace three wide, was in contention to the final furlong and faded. KISS TO REMEMBER was allowed to settle six wide and failed to make headway. SWEET WHISKEY was hustled along five wide, was fanned nine wide leaving the bend, but toiled fruitlessly through the lane. DAME DOROTHY was off slow, settled saving ground, moved up along the inside on the turn, was bumped and checked hard near the five-sixteenths marker and came up empty thereafter. SUPER MAJESTY was hustled along between horses four wide through the turn and tired. FIORETTI was close up off of the inside, was engulfed on the turn, came in and bumped DAME DOROTHY midway through the turn, and continued to retreat. ARTEMIS AGROTERA was between horses for a half and dropped out.
