Footnotes

STEPHANIE'S KITTEN was unhurried early from the five path, gradually moved inside nearing the far turn, shifted into the three path entering the lane, split horses inside the eighth pole, took a clear advantage, veered out under left handed urging but remained clear in the final stages. LEGATISSIMO (IRE) stumbled badly at the start, was tough to settle entering the first turn, swung into the six path in the far turn, rallied in the stretch, steadied a bit late but hung in the late stages. QUEEN'S JEWEL (GB) broke awkwardly, was forced in and bothered before the first turn, settled back through the backstretch, fanned into the seven path in the far turn with a late gain in the stretch run. SENTIERO ITALIA chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid entering the lane but flattened out late in the stretch drive. PHOTO CALL (IRE) came out a bit at the start, stalked the pace early three wide, shifted into the three path in the far turn, took over and inched clear inside the eighth pole but faltered late in the drive. WATSDACHANCES (IRE) was reserved early, shifted into the three path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch run but leveled out late. SECRET GESTURE (GB) set the pace early, angled off the rail entering the lane but gave way late. MISS FRANCE (IRE) was rank early while getting in a bit heading into the first turn, raced up close through the backstretch, swung to the six path entering the lane and faded late. DACITA (CHI) was in tight and squeezed back a bit through the stretch the first time, raced widest throughout. SHARLA RAE tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and was empty late.
