Weight: 122 lbs.; \$10,000 to pre-enter, \$10,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$1 million purse including travel awards of which 55% to the owner of the winner, 18% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth; plus travel awards to starters not based in Kentucky. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile on the main track.

Footnotes

HIT IT A BOMB settled well off the early pace, raced between rivals into the far turn, was set down four wide entering the stretch, split rivals leaving the three sixteenths, shifted out to about the six path brushing HOLLYWOOD DON inside the eighth pole, closed strongly under right handed rousing and forged ahead in the final strides. AIROFORCE , in close entering the first turn, rated between rivals past the half mile marker, angled out progressing in mid stretch, rallied between runners to be on near even terms in deep stretch and kept on gamely. BIRCHWOOD (IRE) settled in mid pack, came under pressure leaving the far turn, worked his way between runners from the five sixteenths to upper stretch, bid between foes to gain a slim lead with a sixteenth remaining, kept on willingly but was outfinished inside the top pair. CONQUEST DADDYO was squeezed back at the break, steadied early, dropped off the pace while saving ground, angled out in the drive and closed. DRESSED IN HERMES moved up along the rail nearing the first turn, angled out to stalk,

came under pressure mid way on the final turn, reeled in the leader nearing the sixteenth pole, challenged between foes then faded. HIGHLAND SKY hopped at the break then was in tight, pulled his way along past the five eighths, angled out, circled six wide into the lane and finished with interest. MANHATTAN DAN cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, was under some urging nearing the quarter pole, was swarmed over a sixteenth out and weakened. CYMRIC , six wide early, angled in to about the three path entering the first turn and tightened some foes, was under pressure giving hard chase departing the far turn and gave way. HOLLYWOOD DON , four wide early, steadied entering the first turn, chased and gave way. SHOGUN (IRE) saved ground, angled out moving up some past the five sixteenths, lugged in bumping AZAR in upper stretch, regrouped to make a bit of an inside run near the sixteenth marker, steadied off heels and faded. RAY'S THE BAR (GB) , towards the inside, steadied near the half mile pole, steadied again near the quarter pole and came up empty. CAMELOT KITTEN lost ground five wide, was under a drive into the far turn and weakened. AZAR saved ground, was bumped and put in tight in upper stretch and failed to recover. SKY MARSHAL , off the pace, raced four wide between foes near the half mile pole and failed to menace.
