Footnotes

CHAMPAGNE ROOM was floated out to about the four path entering the first turn, corrected and prompted the pace three wide, moved to apply pressure after being called upon past the three eighths, forged to command in upper stretch, kicked away under right handed rousing in mid stretch, drifted in some late and held firm. VALADORNA was rated back from between rivals soon after the break, saved ground leaving the seven furlong marker, came off the inside soon into the backstretch, advanced inside a rival leaving the far turn, angled out and worked her way between foes nearing the lane, brushed with WITH HONORS, straightened away in upper stretch and closed nicely to gain. AMERICAN GAL broke awkwardly and towards the rear, altered out to be about seven wide entering the first turn, corrected and pulled her way forward five wide past the three quarter pole, continued to progress under some rating and still well wide into the far turn, took aim four wide past the five sixteenths, could not quicken with the leaders entering the lane but kept on willingly. DADDYS LIL DARLING, off the early pace while well wide, moved up five to six wide into the far turn, was under hard urging past the five sixteenths, was forced out very wide entering the lane, straightened and continued with interest. JAMYSON 'N GINGER was checked between rivals early, saved ground around the first turn, swung out in upper stretch and had a mild kick. UNION STRIKE broke slowly and was brushed, steadied then was a bit rank into the first turn, raced four wide between rivals leaving the far turn and came up empty. NOTED AND QUOTED quickly went clear, set the pace just off the inside, was taken on past the five sixteenths, stayed on to about mid stretch then gave way. DANCING RAGS bore out at the break and brushed UNION STRIKE, stalked the pace off the rail, was under pressure edging closer between rivals around the far turn, gave futile chase into the lane and faded. WITH HONORS

, bumped and forced out while between rivals nearing the first turn, rated between rivals past the five eighths, was brushed chasing into the lane and gave way. YELLOW AGATE was checked, bumped and carried out nearing the first turn, steadied near the six and a half furlong pole, moved up slightly near the half, checked when bothered entering the lane and gave way. SWEET LORETTA was bumped and stumbled in the jam up into the first turn, stalked off the rail and tired. COLORFUL CHARADES came out bothering foes entering the first turn, saved ground down the backstretch then faltered.
